This workbook contains approximately 10 pages of true/false, multiple choice, matching, identification, and short answer exercises for each chapter of the *American Pageant*. This material is also available in an online version (see below). (If you borrow one, please do not mark them as they will be returned at the end of the year and used for future students.)

Mr. Mercado's Lecture Notes at www.historypageant.com/ushistory.phtml This is an extensive set of lecture notes keyed to the 13th edition of *American Pageant* and a 95 page thematic study guide correlated to the College Board's new AP US History Course Description. Written by a master AP US History teacher, they are a little long, but they do cover almost all of the important material in the chapter and can be more successfully used for test review than the free student outlines. However, even these notes should NOT be substituted for reading the chapter. They are available in HTML, PDF, and MS Word formats. Lecture notes from 1400-1800 are free. The remaining chapters cost \$25 for a one year subscription.
